We ensure that our children and young people benefit from being part of the family of schools within Oldham. The school has strong partnerships with mainstream schools and other community providers.

We are looking to recruit an energetic and highly motivated Key Stage 2 teacher who will relish opportunities to professionally develop and reflect upon their own practice. Applications from committed and enthusiastic NQTs are welcome. It would be advantageous to have knowledge of autism. In addition, applicants must:

- Be able to demonstrate previous experience in a teaching role at Key Stage 2
- Be able to motivate children and build progress and confidence
- Possess the emotional and physical resilience necessary when working with young people with a range of complex needs
- Have the ability to foster good relationships with other staff, students, parents and the wider community
