Our new AP free school, the Springboard Project opened in September 2019. We support the learning, social and pastoral needs of over 700 young people aged between 4 and 19 years.

Hollinwood Academy caters for pupils with a diagnosis of ASC and a range of Social, Emotional and Mental Health (SEMH) difficulties between the ages of 4 – 19. Our curriculum and philosophies provide opportunities for academic and social development that will enhance the life opportunities for our young people. Classes are small and teaching staff work closely alongside support staff to provide the very best learning experience through creative and innovative approaches.

We currently have a vacancy for a compassionate, energetic and highly motivated Science Teacher to work within the secondary phase of this specialised provision.

The Trustees would like to invite applications from excellent practitioners with experience of teaching all three disciplines of science: Biology, Chemistry and Physics to GCSE. We would be interested in applicants with experience of supporting children or young people with Autism or Special Educational Needs within the primary or secondary sector. Alternatively, we would welcome applications from less experienced people / NQTs who can demonstrate a genuine interest in supporting SEND pupils and who are looking to work for an organisation which provides opportunities to develop and progress.

The successful candidate will:

- Be an excellent Science practitioner with the commitment and motivation to inspire pupils' learning and development
- Have experience of teaching all three disciplines of Science: Biology, Chemistry and Physics at Key Stages 3 and 4 ranging from lower level learners to GCSE
- Be able to demonstrate a commitment to continuous improvement and innovation through imaginative and differentiated lessons which meet individual needs
- Have experience of enhancement of pupil progress gains and raising attainment and achievement levels of all pupils
- Have experience of current assessment practice and the use of data and pupil progress tracking to ensure that all groups of learners achieve
- Have specific experience / interest in working with pupils with SEND
- Possess the emotional and physical resilience necessary when working with young people with a range of complex needs
- Have the ability to foster good relationships with other staff, pupils, parents and the wider community
- Be hard working, organised and proactive in their professional development
